

EXTENSION OF LOCAL DECLARATION OF "A STATE OF EMERGENCY"

"A State of Emergency" is herewith declared in the Town of Amherst, County of Erie, in the State of New York, for the period beginning at Midnight on March 15, 2020 is hereby extended to June 15, 2021.

A State of Emergency has been declared due to the rapidly evolving challenges to protect the public health and safety related to the spread of COVID-19 affecting all of the Town of Amherst. Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of the Town of Amherst.

As the Supervisor of the Town of Amherst, I, Brian J. Kulpa pursuant to authority given to me in sections 24 and 25 in Article 2B of the NYS Executive Law, direct all town personnel and all departments of the town to take all actions deemed necessary and appropriate to cope with the disaster or any emergency therefrom.
