CONTEST RULES

2. All entries must include first and last name, address, phone number, and email.

3. The contest is open to all Amherst residents of public, private and homeschool high school students. Students are not limited in how many entries they can submit. More than one entry is welcomed.

4. The slogan must be original and if there are two or more entries that are the same or similar the first entry submitted will be considered.

5. All entries become the property of the Town of Amherst to be used for governmental purposes.

6. The Town of Amherst reserves the right to use a part of the winning slogan to create a new slogan and the Town of Amherst is not obligated to use the winning slogan.

7. The Amherst Town Board will make the final decision of the winners. There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes awarded.

8. The winners will be announced in October 2018.
