EAST ROBINSON ROAD/ NORTH FRENCH ROAD

East Robinson/North French Road (C.R. 299) is a minor east-west arterial highway traversing the length of the Town. The segment beginning at Niagara Falls Boulevard and ending at Sweet Home Road is considered a Commercial Corridor. North French Road, beginning at Sweet Home Road and ending at Transit Road, is considered to be a Suburban Corridor.

Within the Commercial corridor, access management tools that could be implemented include: removal/relocation of driveways within the functional area of intersections, restricting turning movements to/from driveways, driveway consolidation and increasing access between parcels.

Within the Suburban corridor, access management tools that could be implemented include: removal of driveways within the functional area of intersections, restricting turning movements to/from driveways, constructing traffic calming measures such as medians and curb extensions.



Commercial driveway opposite residential (between Niagara Falls Boulevard and Sweet Home Road).

E. Robinson Road/N. French Road is currently under design for rehabilitation and reconstruction. The Town should work closely with the County to implement the recommended access management measures to the fullest extent possible.

Much of North French Road between Sweet Home Road and Transit Road is Suburban residential in character.



Consideration should be given to relocate or remove curb cuts within the functional area of the intersection at North French Road and Campbell Boulevard .



Reverse frontage development along North French Road near Dodge Road minimizes curb cuts.
