(Amherst, NY) – The Amherst Town Board and Building Department announce the return of the popular "Gingerbread House Building Permit" program to encourage junior builders to consider design and structural elements in their holiday gingerbread house. Junior builders, age 12 and younger, are invited to participate by completing an application.

"Over the years we have received many creative designs as our young builders look to design the best, biggest, or most colorful gingerbread house. This is a great program to combine creativity and engineering," said Deputy Supervisor Shawn Lavin.

Young builders are welcome to complete an application to receive an "official" Town of Amherst Gingerbread House Building Permit. Young builders who submit a design that is approved will receive a "building permit" to commence their work.
