

SCHOOL TAX BILLS TO BE MAILED MID-SEPTEMBER

Town Clerk's Office Shares Info on School Tax Bill Distribution

(Amherst, NY) — The Town Clerk's Office would like to inform residents that school tax bills will be mailed out around mid-September. This timing allows Erie County to complete its portion of the billing process before bills are finalized and distributed.

"Until the County's processing is complete, we cannot provide exact amounts for individual tax bills," said Amherst Town Clerk, Francina Spoth. "Residents can check their tax bills online by visiting the Town's website at www.amherst.ny.us and using the keyword 'TAX BILL' to access the relevant page. By entering your address, you can view a historical overview of your property taxes, and once the new bill is generated, it will appear on this page, typically a day or two before you would receive it in the mail."

Please note that no new tax amounts will be available until mid-September. If you do not receive your bill by September 30th, contact the Clerk's Office.
