

## The Amherst Police Department Citizen Police Academy (CPA) is accepting applications for the 2024 Academy.

The next CPA program will begin on February 27th and will run for 13 consecutive weeks, with the final class being held on May 21st. Classes are from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. on Tuesdays at either the Amherst Police Headquarters, 500 John James Audubon Parkway, or the Amherst Police Department Community Policing and Training Facility at 4220 Bailey Ave.

The CPA is open to adult town residents as well as individuals who are employed within the geographic boundaries of the Town of Amherst. The CPA has been a highly successful program in the past and has been well-received and appreciated by prior attendees. Topics to be covered in the coming year's program will include a tour of headquarters, recruitment, and training of the officers, crime prevention, accident investigation, and criminal investigation. Other topics include crime intelligence, firearms, crime scene processing, domestic violence, criminal law, narcotics, gambling, and vice. Presentations will be held by the Traffic Bureau, Detective Bureau, Emergency Response Team, Crime Lab, Special Victims Unit, K-9 Unit, and more. Students in the class will be allowed to ride-along on patrol with an officer.
