#### 2021 Resident Photo ID Card Information

A valid town of Amherst Resident Photo ID card is needed to register for programs and services and to receive resident discounts for open skate sessions. Resident ID cards also allow for unlimited free use of the Clearfield and North Forest pools during the summer months. ID cards are valid for one calendar year.



Mid-Winter and Spring Recess Programs are for youth ages 5-11.


